



The Toyota Land Cruiser 79 is the ideal vehicle for any self-drive lodge or camping tour. Transfer & Office Hours

Maximum 2 Transfers included in rental: Transfer will be provided for guests from and to Windhoek International Airport to the depot situated in Windhoek City Centre.

Transfers after the return of the Vehicle are subject to specified times and schedules.

Charges of N\$350.00 per person will apply for all additional transfers pre-booked. This includes transfer that fall outside of schedules or in case of delays or alternations in the transfer times and destinations.

Latest returns and transfers to airport at week days are scheduled at 16:00

Fuel Level

Please note that vehicles are handed over with a full fuel tank. Before returning the vehicle, please fill up the fuel completely and provide proof thereof to the rental agent. In case the vehicle was not refueled or no proof was provided, the supplier will refuel the vehicle and costs +5% surcharge will be charged to your credit card.

Use of 4x4 mode:

The following maximum speed limits are not allowed to be exceeded when using the 4x4 mode:

H4 (High range) 60 km/h

L4 (Low range) 30 km/h

Switch to the four-wheel drives, H4 or L4, only when the vehicle has come to a full stop and only when the clutch is pressed in! In an automatic vehicle the gear lever must be in neutral.

It is not allowed to use the 4x4 mode (H4 or L4) on tar roads or good gravel roads!

The L4 is only allowed for short-term use in areas with deep sand, steep inclines/declines!

By using the 4x4 mode incorrectly/permanently, the renter will be held liable for the full amount in damages.

Speed limits:

The general speed limits in Namibia may differ to those prescribed by the supplier. It is the renter's responsibility to adhere to the speed limits prescribed by the supplier unless lower speeds are prescribed by law.

The Client (including any and all additional drivers) must keep to the prescribed speed limitations:

Tar Roads: Maximum 120km per hour (for all Vehicle Types)

Not Tarred Roads: Maximum 80 km per hour (for all vehicle types)

By not adhering the Speed Limit as set out above, the Insurance cover will expire and will be invalid.
